

EINSTEIN SCHOLARSHIPS: A MULTI-YEAR COMMITMENT

Einstein Scholarships are awarded to the University's most academically gifted students over the course of their BA, MA or Ph.D. degree program. Donors agree to fund the student(s) for the duration of the degree.

MECHINA ONE-YEAR SCHOLARSHIPS

Mechina Scholarships are awarded to economically disadvantaged, but academically promising high school students who qualify to enroll in the Hebrew University one-year preparatory program. Mechina enables students to gain the knowledge and skills they need in order to apply for admission to a Hebrew University undergraduate degree program.

ROTHBERG INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

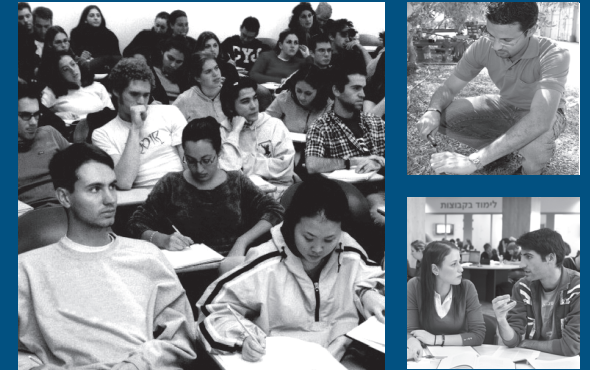

RIS awards only partial scholarships; all are needs-based unless a donor directs that the award be based solely on merit.

OPPORTUNITIES TO FUND SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS AT THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY OF JERUSALEM



We invite you to consider opportunities to fund scholarships that are vital to the continuing matriculation of Israel's top secondary school students at The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, and which help to assure that they successfully complete their undergraduate and graduate studies.

Scholarships not only create opportunities for worthy students to attend the leading University of the State of Israel, but also create bridges between American Friends and Israel's best and brightest—the nation's future leaders. To further this connection, Hebrew University prepares reports* concerning funded scholarship students, along with photographs and updates concerning their educational progress.

Scholarships provide funds for the payment of tuition and fees, the purchase of books and research materials and help to defray students' living expenses. The Hebrew University awards scholarships primarily on the basis of academic achievement and financial need. All donors receive a personalized letter of thanks from American Friends of The Hebrew University. Additional donor recognition is based on cumulative giving levels when funds are designated for scholarship purposes.

Donors may provide outright scholarships or create an endowed scholarship fund through AFHU, named in accordance with a donor's wishes. An endowed fund may be established with a minimum gift of \$100,000 and will fund one or more students annually.

** Each donor of a scholarship gift of \$1,000+ receives a report issued by AFHU and prepared by Hebrew University concerning the donor's funded scholarship students.*

JERUSALEM SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year, thousands of Jerusalem Scholarships, partial and full, are awarded to BA, MA and Ph.D. candidates in every Hebrew University Faculty and School.

Philanthropic Contribution	Provides
Up to \$12,000	Support for 1 or more students
Up to \$24,000	Support for 2 or more students
Founder: \$25,000 +	Support for 3 or more students
Trustee: \$50,000 +	Support for 5 or more students
Guardian: \$100,000 +	Support for 9 or more students

A Jerusalem Scholarship Endowment Fund may be established to benefit both undergraduate and graduate degree candidates unless otherwise specified by the donor.

SCOPUS SCHOLARSHIPS

Scopus Scholarships are awarded by Hebrew University to academically qualified students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds.
